

Bat Removal, Clean up and Exclusion Services



As we are all aware, bats are very beneficial. Feeding on flying insects during our warm weather months.

The negative impact we experience involves their roosting and baby raising sites in and around our dwellings. Plus the potential risks of diseases, bat droppings and rabies associated with these mammals.



Exterior exclusion of entry points and roosting locations are the only effective, responsible, long term beneficial service to pursue.

With that being said, timing of exclusion work is very critical. Make certain whichever contractor you hire completes all exclusion work prior to June 1st or after August 31.

It is extremely important not to trap any young bat pups inside your home during the peak summer months when females are giving birth to their young that can't fly or escape. Female bats only have one pup each summer. Do your part to make sure all leave your home safely. Read our Bat Fact Sheet in the Pest Fact Sheet section to understand this unique mammal better.
